Mrs. Mary C. Murray, widow of the late John H. Murray, of this place died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Van Burchfield, near Cisna Run, on Saturday, 13th, she having made her home there for some years. Mrs Murray was a resident of Landisburg for many years and her many friends here were sorry to hear of her death.

She was an active worker in the M.E. church from early womanhood, and considered no sacrifice too great to make for the advancement of the church. She was always a liberal giver to missions and church work, and was always cheerful and optimistic. Mrs. Murry was a good neighbor and a kind friend, always ready to do a favor, and she will be greatly missed in her church.

The deceased was born, Feb. 11, 1831, died April 13, 1918, aged 77 years, 2 months and 2 days.

- taught grammar school in country schools around Landisburg for a time
  - itinerant preacher..in later years an agnostic
  - studied at Rush Medical School and graduated with an MD--never practiced?
  - delivered 5 of his own babies
  - left Chicago after WW1(the one Howard Murray was in) after all of the boys had come home from Europe
  - worked for the IL Central RR and they let many of the men go in order to employ the veterans.
  - Ruth had an uncle in Harrisburg,PA who asked him to come east and go into business with him..that is why he left
  - the plan was for Ruths mother and her to follow him there after he found a place for them to live...they went there 2-3 yrs later
  - then Harry left the uncle's business(machine shop) to open his own place
  - uncle was an alcoholic and on the day when my father turned around and found Uncle Byron about to hit him with a sledge hammar, he decided to leave that place of business. HIs new shop was moderately sussessful as to income.
  - lived in a rented house on a decent street.
  - Harry contracted typhoid fever and almost died
  - business may have slowed down after he recovered and Ruth's mother decided that she and Ruth would go back to Chicago to live. Harry might have considered selling the business and come there later
  - they corresponded regularly and years went by and the shop did not sell
  - one of the reasons was that an elevated highway was built over his property and the streets were rerouted in such a way that his business was out of the way of traffic. We also had a giant depression coming along and we all had income problems.
  - Ruth said he was a great reader. When he was found in his shop, he was sitting in a rocking chair, having died of a coronary surrounded with bushels of books
  - Ruth said he was quite an artist
