Notes for JAMES GETTYS:

In 1761, one of these early settlers, Samuel Gettys, established a tavern in the area. Just twenty-five years later, his son James had laid out a town of 210 lots with a central town square on the land surrounding the tavern. The town today is Gettysburg. At this time, Gettysburg was part of York County. But by 1790, the growing population of the area decided to separate from York County.

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James Gettys, the founder of Gettysburg, sold his first plot of land in 1787 to John Troxell, Sr. In 1804, Mr. Troxell opened the Sign of the Buck tavern and roadhouse to accommodate those traveling to the western frontier of Pennsylvania and beyond. As our nation grew and Gettysburg became the county seat, this establishment grew to house more travelers. By 1863, the town of Gettysburg was booming with 2,400 residents and many businesses. The hotel, then known as the Union Hotel, served as a hospital for the wounded soldiers after the battle. Indeed, the events that transpired during those three long days in July forever changed the course of our nation's history, Gettysburg's history and this hotel's history.

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1785, James Gettys purchased 116 acres of his father's land including the tavern and laid out the town of Gettysburg, the seat of Adams County PA.

Lived where the town of Gettysburg now stands. James Gettys laid out the town in 1790, in anticipation that it would become the county seat of a new county. His expectations were realized in 1800, when Adams County was created out of the western part of York. He built the first house in the new town; it was used as a tavern for many years but was accidentally destroyed by fire in 1880. He was sheriff 1803-06, and represented the county in the Pennsylvania Legislature, 1807-08-09. He was a brigadier-general in the State Militia in 1812. He had on, when he ran off, a brown underjacket, tow check pantaloons, and half-worn roram hat. Whoever takes up said runaway and returns him to the subscriber, shall have the above reward, but no other charges will be allowed. ANDREW LINN. Toboyne Township, June 22nd, 1826."
