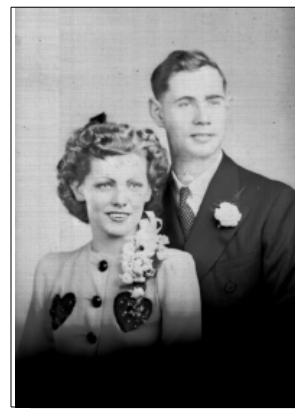

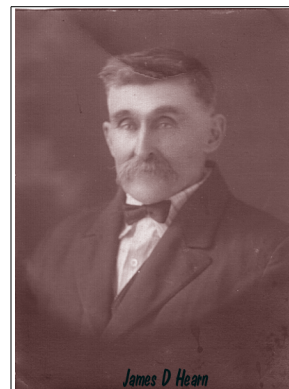

James D. Hearn, a well-known and respected farmer of Bethany Township passed away at his home Wednesday morning, June 14. Mr. Hearn had suffered for several months with heart trouble.

Funeral services were held Friday afternoon at 1 o'clock at the home and 2 o'clock at the Bethany Methodist Church, with Rev. W.E. Ragan officiating.

James Daniel Hearn was born August 12, 1853, in Cephalonia, located on the Ionian Isles that were ceded to Greece. He was a brother to Lafcadio Hearn, a nationally known writer of a quarter a century ago.

At three years of age he was taken to London, England, and lived in that city until adulthood and then came to America.

He settled in Fremont, Ohio, where he was united in marriage to Cora Belle Brubaker. To this union were born nine children, of whom Lilly, Maude, and Jimmy preceded the father in death. Those surviving are Grace, Lottie, Ethel, Mae, Lloyd, and Gladys.

In 1894 Mr. and Mrs. Hearn sought a home in Gratiot County, and settled in Bethany township, where they have since resided. He leaves to mourn his passing the wife, Cora, the children and grandchildren, two half sisters, Posey and Lila of London, England, and a host of friends.

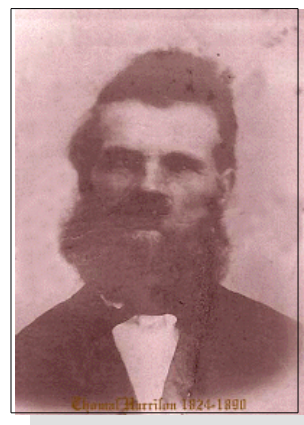

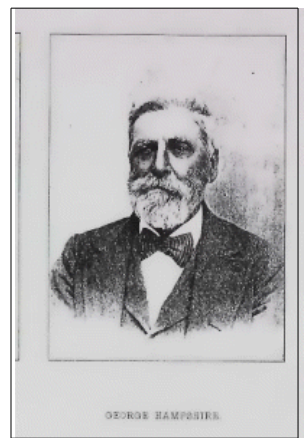

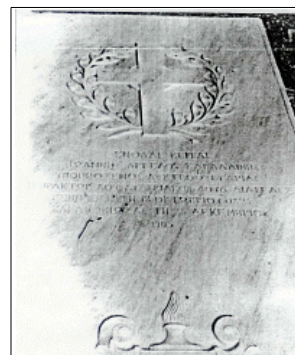

General Notes: Rosa married Charles Bush Hearn, a British Army officer, in her native Grecian Island, Cerigo. She came to Dublin but could not adjust to foreign ways. She returned to Cerigo, leaving her two sons to be raised by her ex-husband's family. She married Cavallini and had four more children. But Rosa died at 59 years in a sanitarium.

Following the marriage annulment, Rosa was betrothed at Cerigo to John (or Giovanni) Cavallini, a young man of Italian descent, of her own age and social standing. Apparently, there was one condition to this marriage; Rosa, at John's behest, was to give up custody of and any claim to her two sons. Thus, the infant Charles (JD Hearn) and his wet nurse were sent back to Britain. Rosa was assured that the two boys would be well provided for; Charles Bush Hearn assumed responsibility for the infant; Mrs. Brenane was to make Patrick one of her heirs.

Rosa and John Cavallini lived at Cerigo except for a short period spent at Cerigotto, a small and sparsely populated island to the south of Cerigo. At Cerigotto, John Cavallini served as governor under the British.

At Cerigo, he was an agent of the Austrian Lloyd and later Vice Consul for Austria-Hungary. An amateur archeologist, he had a large collection of ancient Greek "objets d'art" - vases, graven stones, arrows, lamps, and moneys which he himself had unearthed on Cerigo and Cergotto.³⁶

By this second marriage Rosa had four children, two daughters and two sons, Ziza, Catherine, Angelo, and George. These children and their father all lived to a very great age.

Rosa once returned to the British Isles to look for her two sons there, but as Mrs. Brenane had moved from Rathmines and since the Hearn family would not reveal the boys' whereabouts, she returned to Cerigo without having seen them.

Such bitter disappointments unhinged her mind permanently. Her insanity ultimately manifesting itself in a mania of religious zeal, she was committed to the Mental Asylum at Corfu on March 25, 1872. There she died at the age of fifty-nine years on December 12, 1882.³⁷ Her children had scarcely ever known her. One son, Patrick, no doubt loved her best.

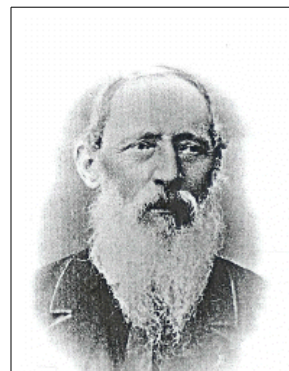

Jonas Hampshire was born October 16,1808, in Baltimore County, Maryland,son of Barney Hampshire, who in 1811 removed his family to Ohio, locating first in Muskingum County, where they lived seven years, and thence removing to Morgan County.

Jonas was married in 1830, in Morgan County, to Mary Swope,daughter of Jacob Swope, and two children were born to them there--George and Henry. In the fall of 1832 the family removed to Seneca County, locating in Jackson Twp.,where Jonas had entered 160 acres of land, and they were pioneers in that region. They continued to reside there for over twenty years.

In 1858 removing to Wood County and settling on section 34, PortageTwp. Here Mr. Hampshire invested in 200 acres of farm land on which the timber was still standing, no trees having been chopped except by coonhunters. He cleared the land, however, and continued to improve it during his lifetime, converting it to valuable property. A hardworking man, he met with well-merited success, at the time of his death being the owner of 316 acres of land east of Jerry City, and 33 acres south, residing on the latter place for some years previous to his decease.

He gave each of his children a farm. He became quite prominent in Jackson Twp., Seneca County, where he served as township trustee and assessor, and he was an ardent believer in the principles of the Democratic party.

Having an natural aptitude for military tactics, he took great interest in such affairs, and was captain of a company of home militia in Jackson County, Seneca County, Ohio.

Mr. Hampshire passed from earth July 29, 1892, in Bloom Twp. and was laid to rest in the Jerry City Cemetery. He was a member of the Lutheran Church.

She still retains a farm of twenty acres, which is managed by her son Frank, together with his own 131 acres which was part of the old homestead.

Both parents of Mrs. Brubaker were born in Germany, the father on 5 September 1832, and the mother on 2 March 1835. They still survive and are among the highly esteemed residents of the township. In the name of God, I, William Forster, preacher in Thorn Township in the County of Fairfield and State of Ohio, yeoman, though reduced in low estate of bodily strength, yet being of sound mind, memory and understanding, and considering the uncertainty of this life, have thought it fit to make this my last will and testament, in the manner following. That is to say, First, I recommend my soul into the hands of God, and my body I commend to the earth, and respecting the worldly estate and effect, wherewith it has pleased God to help me, I dispose of them in the following manner. That is to say, it is my will that I give and bequeath --

(1) my eldest son, William Foster, 160 acres of land, as the deed calls for, clear of all debts and expenses.

(2) I give and bequeath to my son Andrew Foster 160 acres of land, as the deed calls for.....etc

And it is further my will that when my youngest son comes to the age of 21, to get equally from all the boys, and it is my will that each of my sons give to my beloved wife, Magdalena Foster, yearly to have two bushels of wheat to get it ground, bring flour and bran to her house, also each of them is to give her one pound of coffee and four pounds of sugar, and four pounds of salt and two pounds hackled flax, two pounds of tow, and two bushels of corn all to be brought to her house. I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife, Magdalena Foster, one mare and it is my will that my son, George Foster, is to keep her as his own for the use. Also I allow her to put up one of her hogs that is willed to her for her own use.

(9) I give and bequeath to my son, Benjamin Foster, 160 acres of land...etc

(10) I give and bequeath to my son, Christian Foster, 160 acres of land as mentioned in his deed. He is to have one horse colt, one cow, two sheep, four hogs and shovel plow. It is my will that Christian Foster is to give note to his brother, Samuel, for the debt I owe him for \$50.00 with sufficient bail.

(11) I give and bequeath to my oldest daughter Mary to have 126 acres of land...etc

(12) I give and bequeath to my daughter Catherine 125 acres of land...etc

(13) I give and bequeath to my daughter Magdalene 125 acres of land...etc

And it is further my will that my son, Samuel Foster, is to have my horse for \$100 and to give credit on each of these notes that he has of his brothers Henry, George, Benjamin and Christian Foster. And if Samuel shall refuse to take the horse, then my sons William, Andrew, Henry, Samuel, George, Benjamin and Christian Foster shall sell my horse, saddle, bridle and clothes equally to be divided between them, the seven aforesaid.

And it is further my will that my son, Samuel Foster, is to collect my money that is coming to me from all my churches, and to be equally divided between my seven sons: William, Andrew, Henry, Samuel, George, Benjamin and Christian Foster. I

give and bequeath to my beloved wife, Magdalena Foster, all the house furniture, as long as she lives. After her decease it is my will that it be equally divided between my daughters: Mary, Catherine and Magdalena.

I shall be very uneasy about you till you give me y pleasure of hearing from you again.

As you mention your expecting imediaet orders for marching against those disturbers of our peace called ye Oake Boys whom I hope all you Gentlmen of the sword will soon reduce to proper order & make them sensible of their folly & turn them to the Hemp and Oake who I hope will take care they shall not escape without receiving what they justly merite.

Michael (Daniel) Hearn, Archdeacon of Cashel married Miss Anne Doiley. They resided in Stephens Green in the house now forming part of St. Vincent's Hospital.

Sir Bernard Burke told Michael Young these particulars about the house and added that Mrs. Hearn was a very beautiful woman and that crowds used to gather around the door to see her enter or leave her carriage, attracted by the fame of her beauty.

I have heard that the Archdeacon left two sons, about his daughters I am not quite certain but I think there were four or five. Robert, the eldest son, when a Cornet (Fifth commissioned officer in cavalry troops, who carried the colours) in a

dragoon regiment and only 18 years of age, married Miss Cooksey, daughter of a clergyman at, I think Cootehill (or Ballyhaise) & her sister was old Mrs. Baker & Belturbet's mother = who had married a Mr. Mee.

I know nothing of the Archdeacon's second son except that his name was Michael and that he was the ancestor of the Longford's Hearn.

About the daughters I remember my mother saying that the eldest disobeyed her father very much by marrying privately a Mr. Reilly, another whose name was Fridswied married a Councillor Eskinadle (?) & left no family.

Another married Revd. H. Dundee, Rector of Mullinger and another married Godfrey Taylor of ?? in the Co. Tipperary, she also died childless.

My mother knew many particulars about the Archdeacon's wife but I cannot recall them. I only know she came from an old Huguenot family."

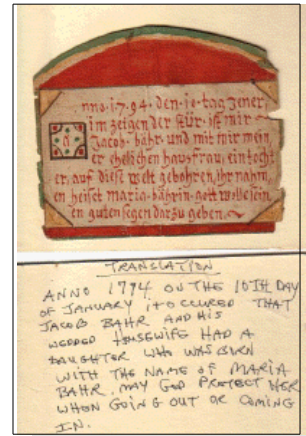

Jacob Brubacher, the son and Fraktur artist, apparently retired from farming in 1786, allowing his son Jacob to assume management.

Unfortunately, a trade for the Fraktur artist was never indicated on the lists. We can assume that he spent his time farming his land and teaching during at least some of the winters. He wrote his own will in 1790, leaving his plantation to his son and listing his children. He made no mention of a wife in the will so that she had probably already died.

The will of Hans Jacob Brubacher II was probated September 18, 1802.

Hans Jacob Brubacher was almost certainly buried in a family cemetery on his farm—a cemetery "in early times known as Brubacher's, now F. Shroder's." Today the cemetery is no longer part of the farm.

Hans Jacob Brubacher is among the earliest recognized Fraktur creators. He continued producing for a fifty-year span. His Fraktur is simple in design, tending to geometrical shapes, but is sometimes colorful. His handwriting over the years is almost unchanged—a small, upright, distinctive script. Hans Jacob, who signed most of his works, has shown what Mennonites at such an early time could do.
